WHAT IS UPDATE

UPDATE # urban upgrading processes is the format of a workshop which operates by creating participatory projects resulting from a deep finding investigation conducted on the sites of intervention. The activities may involve, in addition to public institutions and citizens, local associations and schools triggering with young designers and architects from universities, a debate between users and future professionals that has as its goal the achievement and diffusion of high standards of urban quality through bottom-up dynamics.

UPDATE involves university students and young professionals active in the fields of architecture and design, offering them the possibility to work in interdisciplinary teams for the implementation of targeted interventions of urban renewal and regeneration. A real multidisciplinary research and production laboratory, participated and shared with the local communities that is set up as an engine of responsible environment transformation and of social, economic and cultural development.

GENERAL INFO

UDATE#06 workshop, in its sexth edition, aims to create a public space within a 2.100 sqm green area of municipal property in **Desenzano del Garda**, actually a wasteland behind a shopping mall. Participants will have to face the results of the participatory process started in the last months and find design solutions consistent with the local community expectations. The experience will explore, in addition to extemporary design, techniques of DIY acquiring concepts, skills and handicrafts to build a place of meeting and social gathering.

ORGANIZATION

Participation in the workshop is free; educational materials, equipments and materials required for design activities and self-construction, will be provided by the Municipality of Desenzano del Garda.

The **accommodation on site is offered for free** to all participants selected at a nearby structure. Participants must only cover food and travel costs.

The workshop will be open to a maximum of **15 participants** from all over Europe, selected by the organizers. The residence constitutes a specificity of the UPDATE format, representing a precious opportunity to experience the local environment, know the city and encouraging the exchange of knowledge among figures with different professional and cultural backgrounds.

Co-design, working together and living free time collectively, triggers virtuous dynamics of cooperation, dialogue, intercultural exchange and networking.

At the end of the workshop will be given a certificate of participation.

PROGRAM

The workshop will last 9 days and includes the executive planning and the implementation in self-construction of an intervention by adopting simple, repeatable and sustainable technologies and processes to develop and convey social cohesion by "doing architecture".

The workshop will take place in Desenzano del Garda from July 23th to 31th.
